

The Ornapik $^{\text{\tiny{M}}}$ Spider Pumpkin

Make any small pumpkin (real or foam) into this cute smiling spider using OrnapiksTM and beads from The Beadery[®]. He will be so happy greeting your trick-or-treaters on Halloween.

Materials needed:

8	25 mm Ornapiks™	Black
2	25 mm Ornapiks™	White
4	6.5 x 4 mm Mini Barrel Beads	White
2	14 mm Ring Beads	White
8	9 x 6 mm Oat Beads	Black
32	19 x 6 mm Spaghetti Beads	Black
4	12" Chenille Stems	Black
1	Small Pumpkin (approx. 3½")	




Other items and tools needed:

Round Nose Pliers, Cutting Pliers, Flat Black Acrylic Paint, Silk Flowers (for Decoration)

Instructions:

Step 1: Paint the surface of your pumpkin with flat black acrylic paint and allow to dry completely.

Step 2: Bend the four chenille stems in half and wrap around the point of the round nose plier to create a small loop in the center.




Step 3: String four 19 x 6 mm spaghetti beads and one 9 x 6 mm oat bead onto each chenille stem end to make the eight legs.



Step 4: Push the beads all the way up to the small loop. Trim off excess chenille and curl the ends with the round nose pliers to secure the beads.




Step 5: Slide a black Ornapik™ through each small loop and push them into the pumpkin. If you are using a real pumpkin, a small hole poked through the skin may make this easier to do. Bend the chenille stems to form legs.





Step 6: String four mini pony beads onto one of the chenille stems trimmed in *Step 4*. Curl the ends close to the beads with round nose pliers to secure the beads and trim off any excess.




Step 7: Slide a black OrnapikTM through the two loops on the beaded chenille stem and push them into the pumpkin to form the mouth.





Step 8: Slide a black OrnapikTM through each of the white ring beads and push them into the pumpkin to make the eyes. Finish the eyes with white OrnapikTM.



Step 9: Silk flowers or curly chenille stems may be applied to the stem of the pumpkin for decoration.
