

The Beadery[®] Camo Pop Tab Belt

Make your own camouflage belt with this fast, fun & easy project using plastic Pop Tabs from The Beadery Craft Products.

Materials needed:

- 89 Camo Pop Tabs (7623V551)
- 1 Craft Buckle
- 3 yd (2.7 m) Black Wide Elastic Cord



Other items and tools needed:

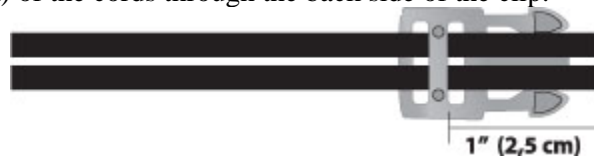
Ruler, Scissors, Hot Glue Gun

Instructions:

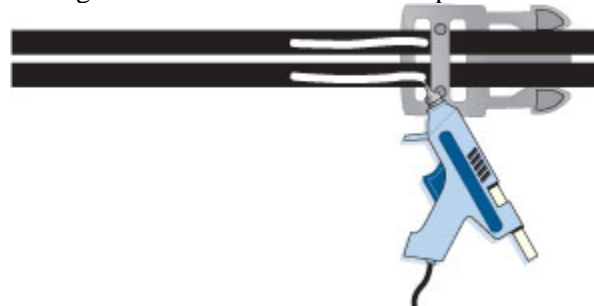
Step 1: Cut the elastic cord into two 1.5 yd (1.37 m) pieces.



Step 2: Thread 1" (2.5 cm) of the cords through the back side of the clip.



Step 3: Place hot glue on the long ends of the cords near the clip.



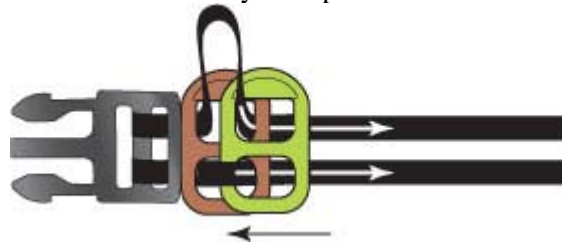
Step 4: Fold the short end of each cord over and press on the hot glue to secure the clip.



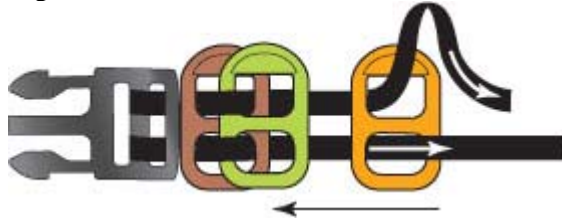
Step 5: Flip the clip over to the front side and slide one random color Pop Tab up to the clip.



Step 6: Place a second random color tab half way on top of the first and run the cord down through both.



Step 7: Run the cords up through another random colored tab.

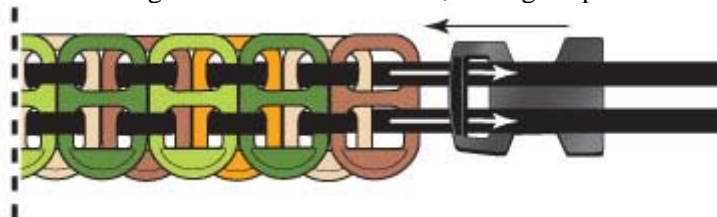


Step 8: Run the cords up through the second tab while sliding the third tab up.

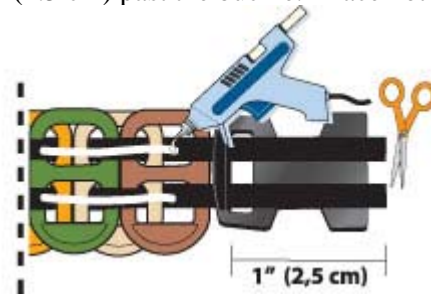


Step 9: Repeat **Step 6 - Step 8** to continue stringing random colored Pop Tabs until all the tabs are used or the desired length is reached. (89 Pop Tabs will make a belt that fits a 30" (76 cm) waist)

Step 10: Flip the belt over and string the buckle on the cords, sliding it up to the last tab.



Step 11: Trim the cords leaving 1" (2.5 cm) past the buckle. Place hot glue on the cord and tabs.



Step 12: Fold the cord ends over and press them down on the glued section to secure.
