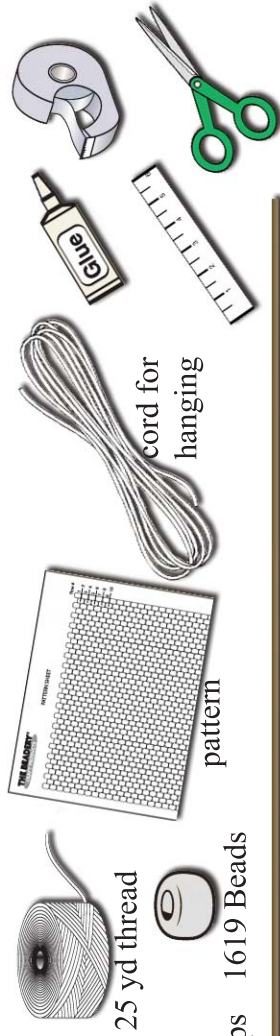
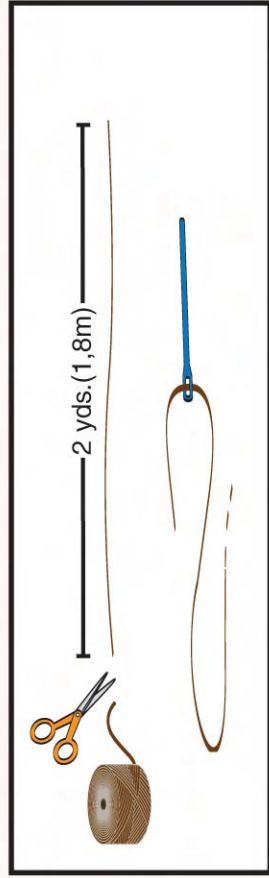


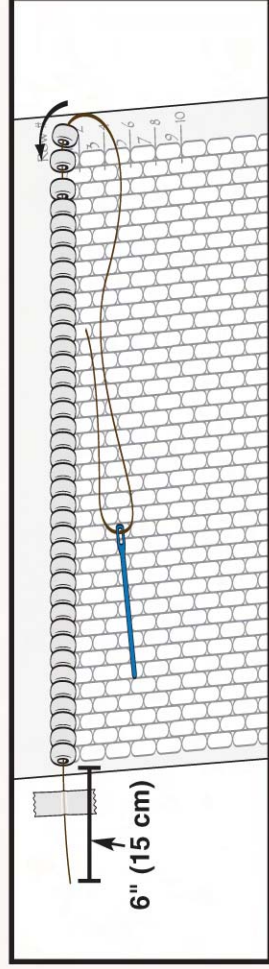
Beaded BannerKit™



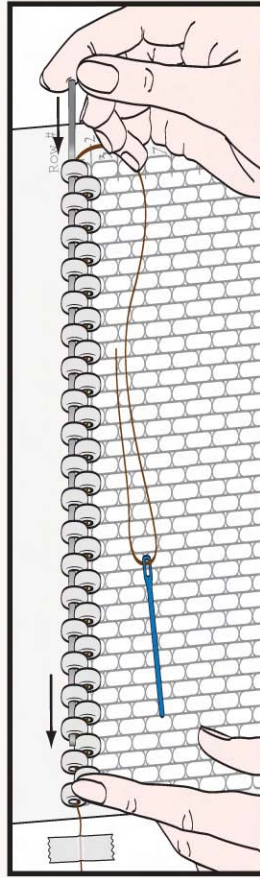
1 Cut 2yds. (1,8m) of thread from spool and thread needle.



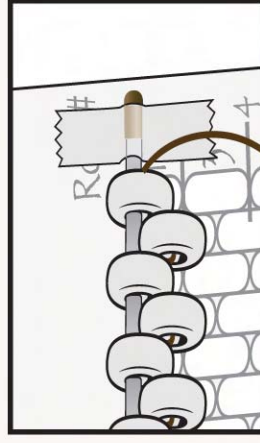
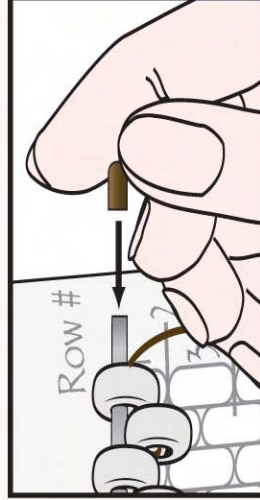
2 Tape pattern to work surface. Tape 6" of thread to left side of row 1. Thread on 39 beads. These beads will become rows 1 and 2.



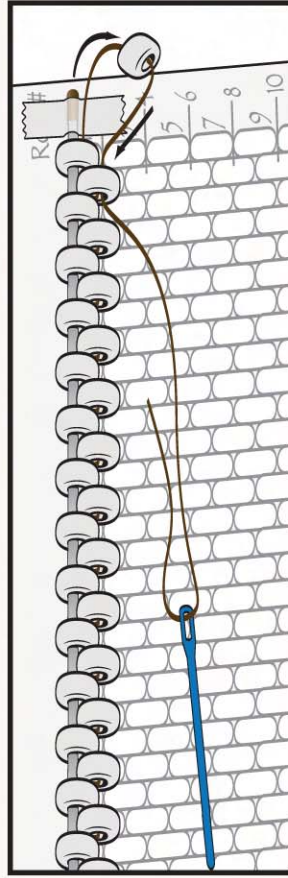
3 Slide metal rod through every other bead to form rows 1 and 2.



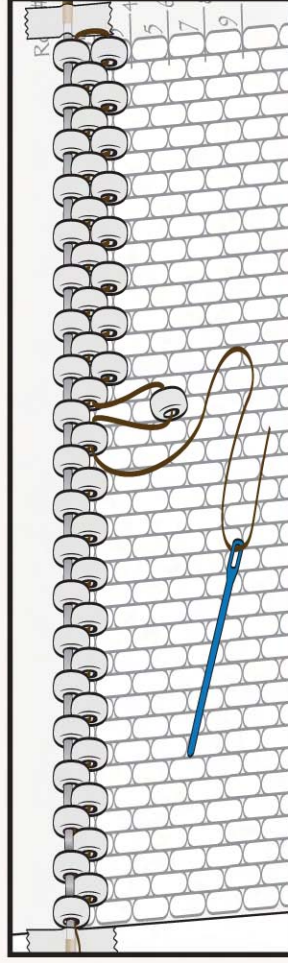
4 Slide end caps onto rod. Tape rod to pattern close to end beads.



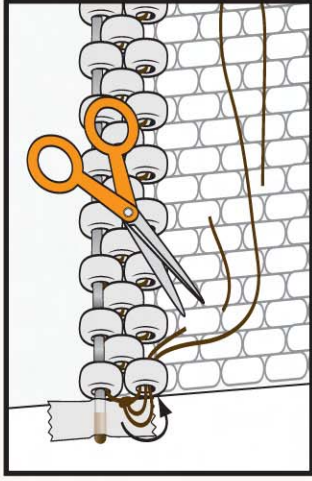
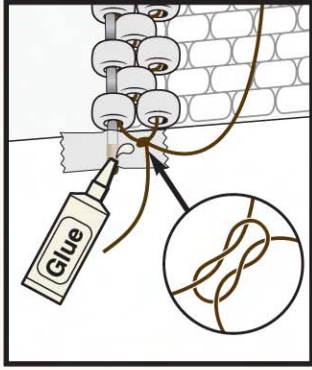
5 String on the first bead in row 3. Pass needle through last bead in row 2 to secure.



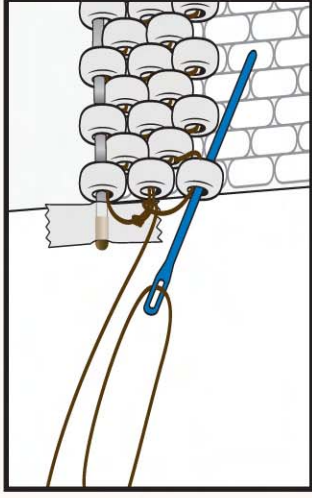
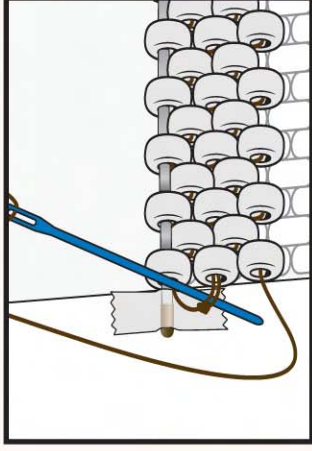
6 Continue adding and securing beads one at a time until row 3 is complete.



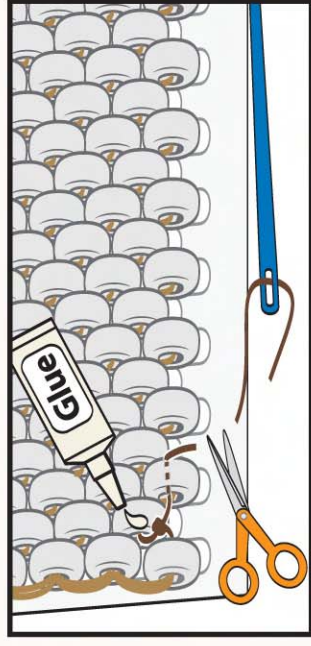
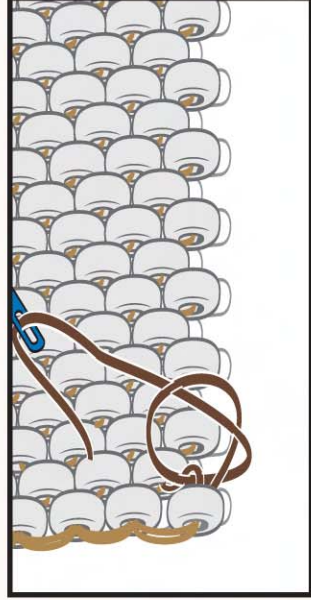
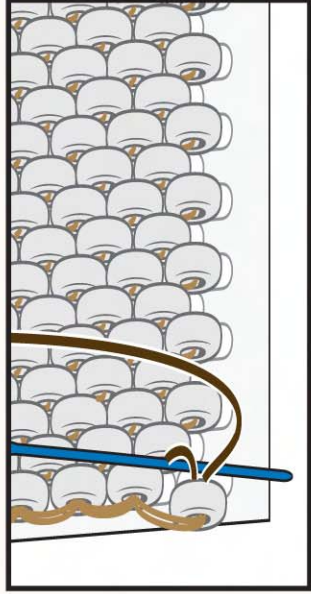
7 Remove tape from thread. Tie threads together using a square knot. Glue knot, pass threads through last bead added and trim excess. Complete rows 4 & 5.



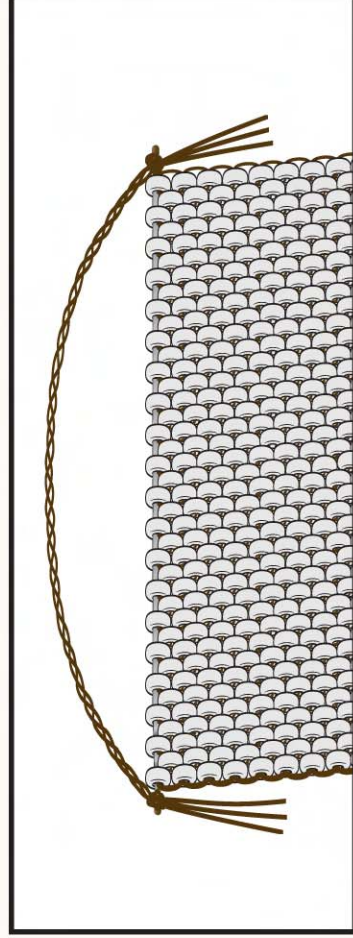
8 Pass needle through outer edge thread. Pass back through last bead added and continue project. (Note: This step must be completed for all left side turns.)



9 At the end of row 83, repeat step 8. To create end knot, pass needle through thread of previous row and back through loop as shown. Repeat end knot. Glue knot and cut excess thread.



10 Attach cord to metal rod and pull knots tight to secure.



Helpful Hints

- Read all instructions before beginning.
- Keep thread tension taut.
- Align beads with pattern sheet after each row.
- When approximately 6" of thread is left on needle attach new thread in 2 yd. lengths, using a square knot.
- To restore finish to beads, rub with a small amount of mineral oil.
