




18. Snug pony beads tightly together. String on three pony beads as illustrated below.




20. String two pearl pony beads onto working cord.




22. Repeat steps 20 through 21 nine more times going around the bracelet and following the color pattern. Thread cord through the three pony beads as illustrated.




19. Thread cord through pony beads as illustrated.




21.Thread cord through opaque green pony bead.




23. Thread working cord under existing cord connecting the pony beads as illustrated below.




24. Tie a double square knot with the two cords. Trim loop end excess cord. Glue knots with clear drying craft glue or clear nail polish to secure.



25. Thread working cord back through the three purple pony beads as illustrated. Keep knot hidden in opaque purple bead.




27. Repeat steps 26 nine more times going around the bracelet and following the color pattern. Thread cord through the two pony beads as illustrated.



26. Attach one pink dangle (made in step 6) as illustrated.

28. Thread working cord back and under cord that connects the purple sparkle bead with the opaque pink bead as illustrated.



29. Keeping dangles snuggly in place, take the loop end and working end of cord and tie a square knot. Glue knot and tuck it into the purple pearl bead to hide it. Trim excess cord.
