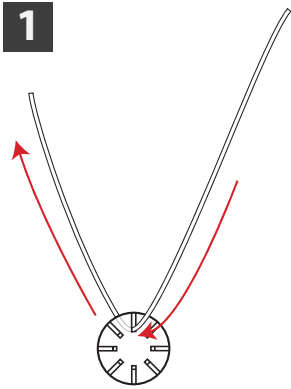


Tips for using the 8-Hole Hub (1165)

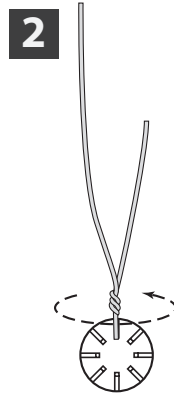
The 8-Hole Hub is the base for many of our star, snowflake and sputnik style Holiday Celebration ornaments. Here are a few tips to help you get started.



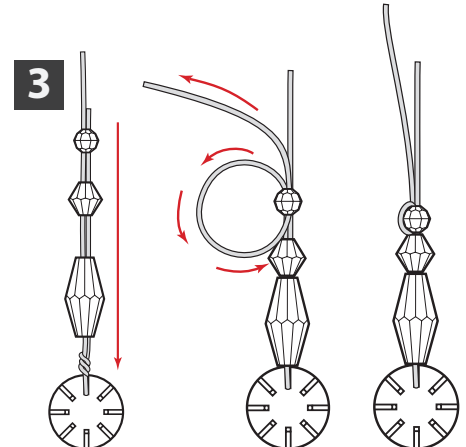
Creating an ornament with a hang loop:



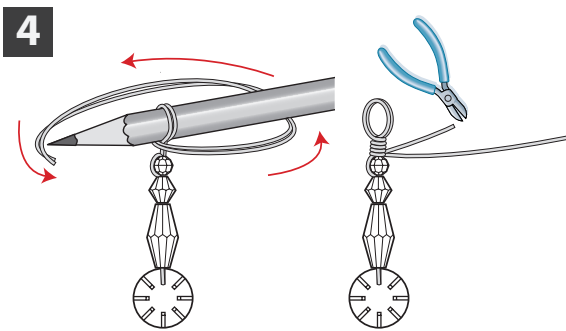
Run wire long enough to make an arm and a hang loop through a hole in the hub. We recommend 28ga wire.



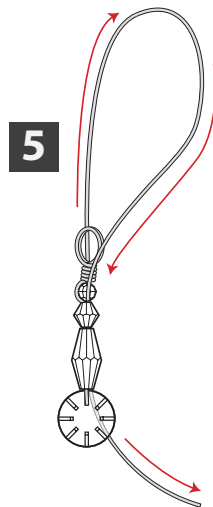
Twist the wire to secure the hub.



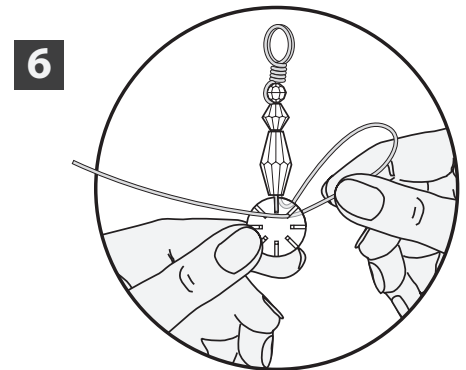
String your beads onto both ends of the wire and secure the last bead by looping the long end of the wire through the bead again.



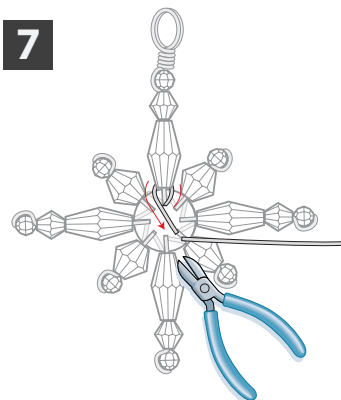
Wrap both wires around a pencil and then tightly around the wires near the last bead to make a loop. Trim the excess from the short wire only.



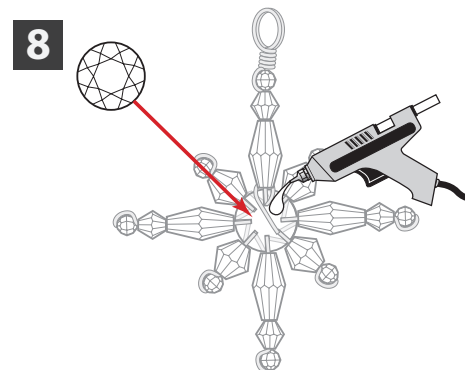
Thread the wire back down through all but the end bead to get back to the hub.



Thread the wire through the next hole in the hub to start the next arm. Repeat steps 3-6 for each arm of the ornament.



When all of the arms are done, wrap the wire around the base of the first arm to secure and trim off excess.



The hub and wire can be concealed by gluing a flat backed stone or other decoration on both sides.
